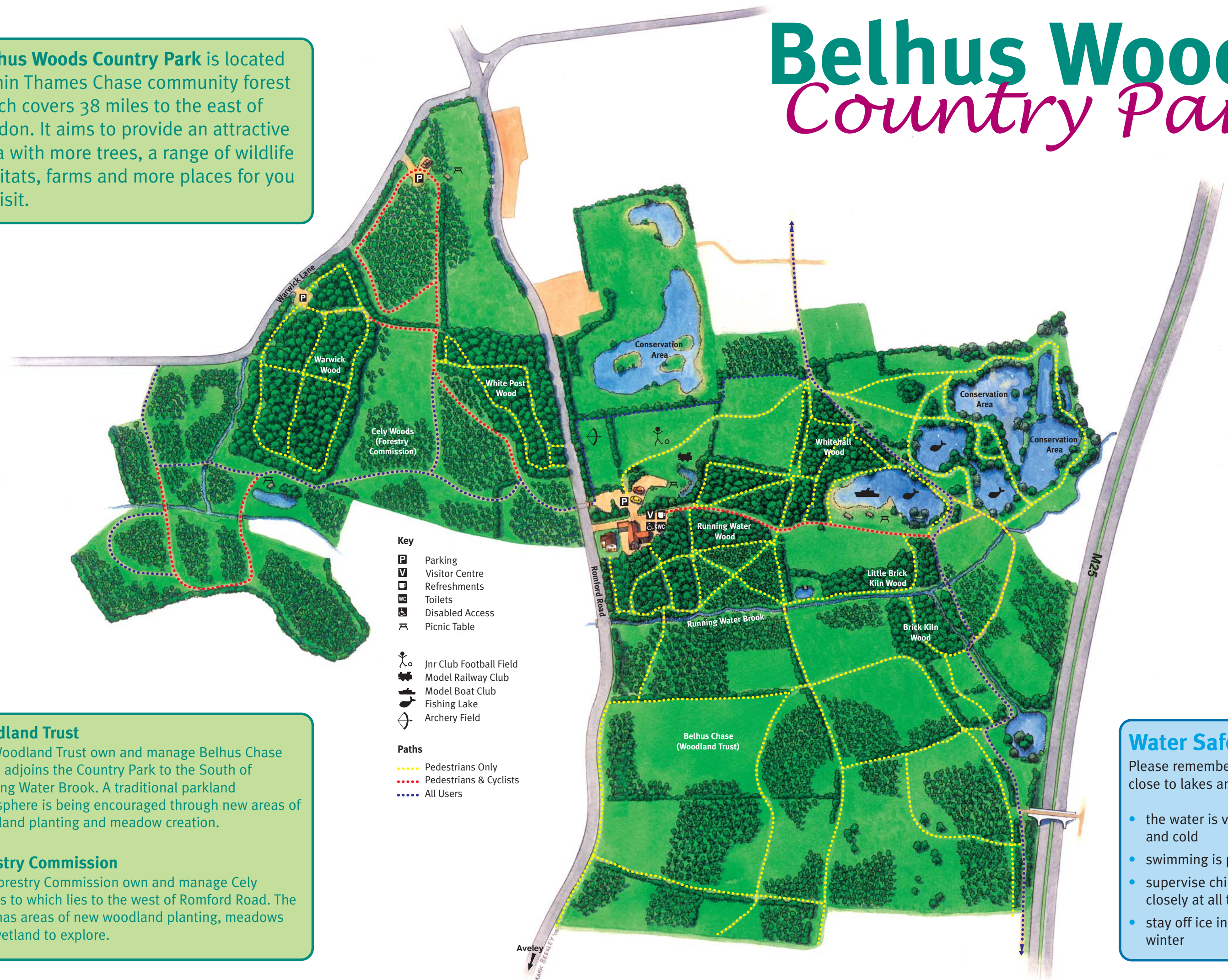


Belhus Woods Country Park

Woodland Trust

The Woodland Trust own and manage Belhus Chase which adjoins the Country Park to the South of Running Water Brook. A traditional parkland atmosphere is being encouraged through new areas of woodland planting and meadow creation.

Forestry Commission

The Forestry Commission own and manage Cely Woods to which lies to the west of Romford Road. The land has areas of new woodland planting, meadows and wetland to explore.
